Connecting simulation scholarship with patient outcomes

Health Sciences North and the Northern Ontario School of Medicine are presenting the 2nd combined colloquium and master class on 'scholarship-driven simulation based education'. This event will bring local and national experts together to explore how simulation based scholarship can influence patient outcomes and improve care in a measurable way.
